



Webinar Report

On

"Diversity of Birds of Karnataka"

One day webinar on diversity of birds of Karnataka on the occasion of world migratory birds day (WMBD) on 09.05.2020 was organised by the department of zoology

The inaugural session begans with welome speech and introduction of inaugrrator of the webinar Sri.Basavaraj Deshmukh, Secretary Sharnbasveshwar Vidyavardhak Sangha. He has inaugurated the webinar and spoken abour birds importance and how they impact on our environment. Birds diversity is decreasing day by day because of deforestation and climate change.

The Secretary of the Sangha congratulated us for organizing such webinars. Also Secreaatary expressed happiness and his best wishes on behalf of the president of college, Dr. Sharnbaswappa Appaji.

After the inaugural, welcome speech was given by Dr. B. Ramakrishna Reddy Organizing secretary, Head Department of Zoology. Dr. B. Ramakrishna Reddy has spoke about birds diversity as they are sensitive to habitat change and are easy to census, birds are important tool for ecologists measuring the health of environment. Whethere ecosystems are managed for agricultural production, wildlife, water or ecotourism, census can be measured by the health and diversity of bird populations. Followed by welcome speech, resource person introduction was given by Pavan Mohanrao, faculty department of zoology.

Technical Session – I

Technical Session I was on "Aves Introduction and their Migration" Delivered by Sri.Vrijulal M.V. Researcher and founder of Harish R.Bhatt Science Foundation, Bengaluru.

He is a ornithologist and given several talks on birds diversity, behavior and their conservation. He has spoken about birds diversity of Karnataka. Karnataka has rich diversity of birds. Western Ghats is home for rich birds diversity and has rich endemism in birds. Every year birds migrate from many country towards Karnataka. Karnataka has many bird sanctuaries. These are suitable place for birds breeding. They will get plenty of food. Birds are very sensitive to other environment. They are biological indicators.

He also focused on courtship behaviour in birds. He also focus on birds evolution and how they evolve from reptiles. And classification of birds, their anatomy, physiology of birds and their habitats.

He also emphasis on birds foraging behviour and foraging models. Also effect on other factors on rate of foraging. Birds are natural engineers they built their nest very facinately. They also show parental care behaviour. All birds show different parental behaviour it varies from species to species. One of best examples for parental care is in Hornbill. Many interesting courtship behaviour and parental care behaviour can be seen in birds.

Technical Session – II

Technical session II is on "The Great Bird Migration of North Karnataka" delivered by Sri.Vivek Krishnamurthy Ornithologist. Karnatak is home to a rare colony of long billed vultures in Ramanagara and endangered great Indian Bustard in Ballari region. Bonal bird sanctuary, Gulbarga District is a paradise for aquatic birds that reveal by this lakeside home. Sanctioned by the government of Karnataka, this is one among Karnataka bird sanctuaries where one can even stay overnight over a camp stay and wake up to a chirpy morning. This sanctuary is second largest bird sanctuary in the state.

Over 10,000 birds migrate to this lake, some of owhich are black ibis, white ibis, bar-headed goose, purple moorhen, purple heron, snake bird, and Indian shag.

North Karnataka has a diverse bird habitat. And one can sight the birds of other western Ghats in uttarqa Kannada, Belagavi and some parts of Dharwad districts, On the other hand, the grassland and arid regions of Ballari, Koppal Raichur have several endangered species. The session ended with short discussion. Both the sessions are informative, interesting and interactive.
